Richard Wedler is the co-inventor of the Micro Fence Edge-Guide System, which was originally devised by both him and his father, who had his own machine company in Ohio where Richard grew up.

Before Richard got into woodworking, he was a folk singer and guitarist, touring the U.S. with the biggest and the best. He still performs in clubs with friends, playing a mean guitar and – yep – the saw.

In 1970 Richard came to California thinking he was going to be recording an album with friends, but eventually realized that woodworking was a more lucrative occupation. Richard has written articles about woodworking, and articles have been written about him and his work in several trade magazines, i.e., CWB, Fine Woodworking, Furniture and Cabinetmaking (UK), etc.

It was Richard's constant desire to create an edge-guide that would solve the problem of quick setups, while also cutting out most of the trial and error guesswork that just frustrates a wood worker. Well, he achieved that dream, and Micro Fence was born.
